### Governor's Ohio Workforce Policy Board Meeting External Partnership Committee Meeting Meeting Minutes – February 18, 2009

#### *Welcome & Committee Member Introductions*

#### *Strategic Intent Brainstorm – Key Ideas:*

- Knit things together to get more money for employer driven training.

- Communicate the board strategic plan to other groups
- Link training providers with companies – state money to create “networks” (public/private)

### ***Top Priorities on Strategic Intent for this Committee***

1. Look to structure a program to incent collaboration of public/private workforce development partnerships

  - b. Export the strategic plan of the board to those groups that can enhance and help execute it

- Get feedback from staff on how to best implement these ideas
- Get examples of best in class public/private partnerships
